Light snack-

AM/PM snack. Also please provide snack if your child is in After Care 3:00pm-6:00pm

Sneakers should be worn by all campers-

Flip-flops, sandals or water shoes for the pool area only. NO flip-flops or sandals during the camp day, please.

Lunch Full Day Campers only

You may bring lunch or purchase lunch for \$5.00 CASH per day. Money can be given to the counselor in the morning. All lunch orders must be in 10:00am

Sunscreen-

Parents are responsible for applying sunscreen prior to the start of camp day. Full day students should have labeled sunscreen to re-apply in the afternoon.

3:00pm-6:00 pm After Care

Hours: 12:00pm-3:00pm
May be added to an existing morning Half Day Camp as a Monday-Friday schedule.

MEDICINE & HEALTH POLICIES



Dispensing of Medicines

All medicines must be signed into the Camp Health Office.

- All medicine must be in original container
- Label must have campers full name, name of medication, along with dosage and dosage times.
- Medicines may not be kept in backpacks or lunch bags

Allergies

Please make sure the Health Office has all updated information regarding allergies along with current action plan. The Atlantic Club is NOT a peanut-free camp. Campers with peanut allergies will be provided a Peanut Free Zone during lunch and snack times.

Forms

(Medical, Immunization, Pick-Up Authorization) must be submitted to our camp office prior to attending camp.

Sunscreen Procedures

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Staff-

All Camp Counselors are trained staff and have backgrounds in education and camp experience. All are certified in CPR, AED and First Aid.

Other-

- Adventure/Mid Day Campers may bring money to visit our SNACK SHACK during lunch time. Rookie Campers DO NOT go to the Snack Shack.
- There are no allowances given for late arrival, early dismissal, vacation or illness.
- Three or more changes will result in a \$15 change fee.
- **Any sign ups on the first day of camp will be charged a \$25 walk in fee.** We must have all camper's information prior to the start of camp.
- Full payment is required at time of registration
- Full refunds will be given until May 15, 2019. Only Camp Credit will be issued after May 15, 2019.
